Description of Duties:

We are seeking a Deputy Attorney General (“DAG”) for the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (“MFCU”) within the Fraud & Consumer Protection Division in New Castle County. The DAG will be responsible for litigating civil state False Claims cases under the Delaware False Claims and Reporting Act and prosecuting a statewide caseload of criminal health care fraud, drug diversion, and patient abuse, neglect, and financial exploitation cases. In addition, the DAG will be assigned to global qui tam False Claim cases managed by the National Association of Medicaid Fraud Control Units. The DAG will participate on global teams on behalf of the Delaware MFCU at the intake, investigation, litigation and settlement stages.

Successful candidates will have civil and/or criminal litigation experience including depositions, document review, motions practice, discovery requests, and trial experience. There is considerable teamwork involved in identifying, investigating and prosecuting healthcare fraud, abuse and waste for both the civil and criminal cases. The attorney will be responsible for leading the unit investigators and auditor in all facets of litigation from inception through trial. This position requires both leadership qualities and substantial interpersonal skills.
