New Castle County Drug Trafficking Task Force  
An Initiative of the Philadelphia-Camden High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area

*This is a one-year contract position without healthcare benefits.*

*The salary is \$70,000 per year.*

The New Castle County Drug Trafficking Task Force (the “Task Force”) – an initiative of the Philadelphia-Camden High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (“PCHIDTA”) – is a collaborative effort among federal, state and local law enforcement agencies to combat drug trafficking, money laundering, drug-related violence and gang threats in the area. It is comprised of three units, each of which has a specific focus within the broader joint mission: (1) DEA Group 41, which investigates complex interstate and international drug trafficking organizations; (2) the FBI Violent Crimes Task Force, which focuses on dismantling violent, street-level crews that sell drugs in Wilmington and its surrounding region; and (3) the First State Fugitive Task Force, which locates and apprehends fugitives wanted for violent and drug-related offenses. Although these units work independently, as members of the Task Force they are required to collaborate and share investigative information with each other, as well as the PCHIDTA.

The Task Force seeks an Investigation Analyst for a one-year contract position to assist in implementing a Drug Market Intervention (“DMI”). A DMI eliminates an overt drug market by identifying, investigating, and prosecuting the worst and most violent dealers in that market, while giving less-dangerous offenders an opportunity to rehabilitate themselves without involvement in the criminal justice system. The analyst will review crime data and work with other members of law enforcement to select a drug market in New Castle County for a DMI. Thereafter, the analyst will help to identify all active dealers in that market and assist in determining which of those dealers are the most dangerous to the community. Finally, the analyst would evaluate and assess the impact of the DMI program on the community and make recommendations for future improvements to the program.

The Analyst is a one-year contract position funded through the Office of National Drug Control Policy. The salary for the position is \$70,000 per year and healthcare benefits are not provided.

Applicants will have strong analytic, organizational, and communications skills. Moreover, applicants should have experience in collecting, compiling, analyzing and interpreting data from various sources, and be literate with a wide-variety of computer applications. Familiarity with criminal databases and intelligence platforms such as Memex/Patriarch, DELJIS, LEISS, Accurant, Case Explorer, Pen-Link, Babel Street and Palintir is preferred. Any offer made is contingent on the successful completion of a background check.
