Description of Duties:

We are seeking a Deputy Attorney General (“DAG”) for the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (“MFCU”) within the Fraud & Consumer Protection Division in New Castle County. The DAG will be responsible for prosecuting a statewide caseload of criminal healthcare fraud, drug diversion, and patient abuse, neglect, and financial exploitation cases as well as litigating civil state False Claims cases under the Delaware False Claims and Reporting Act. In addition, the DAG will be assigned to global qui tam False Claim cases managed by the National Association of Medicaid Fraud Control Units. The DAG will participate on global teams on behalf of the Delaware MFCU at the intake, investigation, litigation and settlement stages.

Successful candidates will have criminal and/or civil litigation experience including depositions, document review, motions practice, discovery, and trial experience. There is considerable teamwork involved in identifying, investigating and prosecuting healthcare fraud, abuse and waste for both the civil and criminal cases. The attorney will be responsible for leading the unit investigators and auditor in all facets of litigation from inception through trial. This position requires both leadership qualities and substantial interpersonal skills. Delaware bar admission is required.
