- 2. permit the Division to inspect and copy or photograph any results or reports of physical or mental examinations and of scientific tests or experiments made in connection with the particular case, or copies thereof, within the possession or control of the Respondents, which the Respondents intend to introduce as evidence in chief at the hearing or which were prepared by a witness whom the Respondents intend to call at the hearing when the results or reports relate to that witness's testimony; and
- 3. disclose to the Division any evidence the Respondents may present at the hearing, which if presented at a court proceeding would be submitted pursuant to Rules 702, 703, or 705 of the Delaware Uniform Rules of Evidence. This disclosure shall be in the form of a written response that includes the identity of the witnesses and the substance of the opinions to be expressed;
