



2. Respondent will file with the Division an amended BD Form to accurately answer Question #7(D)(5).


3. Respondent consents to a reprimand for the inaccurate answer to Question #7(D)(5) on the BD Form originally filed with the Division.


4. The Division will approve Respondent's amended application for broker-dealer registration in the State of Delaware, subject to the conditions below.

5. Respondent agrees to promptly inform the Division, in writing, of any and all customer complaints of Delaware residents for the period of twelve (12) months from the date of Respondent's registration as a broker-dealer.


6. It is in the public interest that this Consent Order be entered. This Consent Order shall take effect immediately upon execution by the Commissioner.
