Description of Duties:

The Delaware Department of Justice is seeking an exceptional and highly motivated individual to lead the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (“MFCU”) as the Director, in the Fraud and Consumer Protection Division in New Castle County. The primary responsibility for this Deputy Attorney General is to manage a statewide multidisciplinary team of 17 professionals responsible for identifying and prosecuting, both criminally and civilly, fraud by providers in the Medicaid system and medication diversion, financial exploitation, and patient abuse and neglect at facilities that receive Medicaid funding. The MFCU team includes Deputy Attorneys General, Special Investigators, auditors, a nurse analyst and three staff.

In addition, as Unit Head, the Director will oversee global qui tam False Claim Act and Reporting cases coordinated by the National Association of Medicaid Fraud Control Units. The Director will be responsible for independently managing a caseload of complex criminal and civil matters and partnering with various federal, state and civilian agencies to investigate allegations of provider fraud, waste and abuse against the Medicaid program. Other duties may include: provide assistance to the Fraud and Consumer Protection Division Director, perform legislative research and drafting, respond to public records requests, oversee annual HHS-OIG grant reporting requirements, and attend various health-care fraud related stakeholder meetings.

This is a challenging position that requires oversight over complex criminal and civil proceedings, fraud investigations and interagency coordination. Applicants must be self-motivated and possess the ability to exercise good judgment and decision making within a collaborative team structure both internally and with external stakeholders. Demonstrated management experience is preferred. Experience with Medicaid fraud, healthcare fraud and/or complex financial crimes is preferred. Strong research, writing, and legal advocacy skills are required. Must be a member of the Delaware bar. We seek an individual with a strong commitment to working in the public interest.
