Description of Duties:

The Department of Justice is seeking a Deputy Attorney General for the Family Division, to serve in the Child Protection Unit. This Deputy Attorney General primarily represents the Division of Family Services (“DFS”) in their often complex Dependency and Neglect hearings, Termination of Parental Rights hearings and Child Protection Registry hearings before the Family Court. This Deputy Attorney General also represents DFS in Supreme Court appeals resulting from the various hearings. Deputy Attorneys General in the Unit file and respond to pleadings in the Family Court, participate in case planning meetings, and prepare appellate briefs.

A qualified candidate’s strengths will include the ability to work independently, evaluate cases, meet deadlines, anticipate legal issues, and research accurately and effectively. Candidates must have the ability to learn and apply relevant laws and court rules. Candidates must also have excellent verbal and written communication skills. Related experience in Family Court is preferred. The position will require some statewide travel to various meetings and hearings.
