DEPUTY ATTORNEY GENERAL

Family Division, Juvenile Delinquency & Truancy Unit, New Castle County

Description of Duties:

Come work for Delaware's largest law firm! The Delaware Department of Justice seeks a Deputy Attorney General to represent the State of Delaware in felony and misdemeanor juvenile delinquency prosecutions.

This position focuses solely on juvenile justice. Delaware juvenile prosecutors work in a fast-paced, fulfilling, and dynamic team environment. Members of the Juvenile Delinquency and Truancy Unit are in Court on a weekly basis and try cases regularly. Those chosen for this position become some of Delaware's best trial attorneys.

More importantly, in this role, prosecutors have the ability to make a direct and meaningful impact on the lives of juveniles all across New Castle County, in addition to ensuring justice for victims and keeping the community safe. Prosecutors who work in the Department of Justice should be guided by a desire to "do the right thing" and be prepared to have an immediate influence on the lives of others.

The Juvenile Delinquency and Truancy Unit also focuses on prioritizing employee mental health and wellbeing. This Unit is committed to providing prosecutors with a strong work/life balance. In addition, following a six month period, the successful applicant may have the ability to work from home up to two days a week as long as it does not interfere with Court responsibilities.

Successful applicants will receive training, feedback, support, and mentoring from our experienced New Castle County leadership team. All prosecutors also receive training presented by the Department of Justice's Training Coordinator and will be able to attend training at the DOJ's Annual Retreat.

Beyond a strong desire to serve the public, strengths should include the ability to evaluate criminal cases, determine resolutions, and anticipate legal issues. As a member of the law enforcement community, prosecutors must be able to develop a

good working relationship with other Deputy Attorneys General, law enforcement, support staff and Court personnel. Qualified applicants must have good interpersonal skills as they will be expected to communicate with members of the public.

At time of hire applicants DO NOT have to be admitted to the Delaware Bar but must have graduated from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctorate and proceed to be admitted to practice pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 55 and take the Delaware Bar exam in a timely manner.
