Description of Duties:

This Deputy Attorney General (“DAG”) position is a *civil* enforcement position in the White Collar Crime Unit (“WCCU”), Fraud & Consumer Protection Division. Based in New Castle County, the WCCU enforces civil and criminal laws involve financial misconduct and fraud committed against the government. The WCCU team includes DAGs, a Special Investigator, Forensic Auditors and Legal Assistants. This DAG will be primarily assigned to the WCCU’s investigation and prosecution of civil actions for fraud committed against the State of Delaware through enforcement of the Delaware False Claims and Reporting Act.

The Delaware False Claims and Reporting Act (“DFCRA”) provides that actions can be pursued and monetary damages recovered from individuals or organizations that commit fraud against the State, any of its agencies, or its subdivisions. This DAG’s primary responsibilities will involve conducting investigative efforts, including but not limited to witness interviews, document collection and review, and litigating actions pursuant to enforcement of the DFCRA. The DAG may also have other assignments within WCCU and will be expected to assume criminal, civil and administrative duties to support the WCCU as the need arises.

This DAG position works in coordination with a companion DFCRA DAG posting in the Department of Justice's Civil Division as part of the Attorney General's multi-pronged effort to combat fraud perpetrated against the government.

This is a challenging position that provides an opportunity to pursue large and complex investigations and cases of a high priority to the office. Applicants should be able to evaluate evidence and applicable authority in the context of civil and criminal cases, to determine prospective resolutions and anticipate legal issues, and to research independently and effectively. The successful applicant must have or be able to develop a good working relationship with deputy attorneys general, investigative personnel, support staff and agency representatives. Experience in prosecuting complex litigation before the Delaware courts is beneficial, as is a familiarity with financial and accounting matters. We seek an individual with a strong commitment to working in the public interest.
